Painted Orchid.....

Ok, it's not really painted, yet it is. I used a technique called painting with light. This is done by having your room completely dark. No light can be streaming in from anywhere. You then open the shutter on your camera (this one was a 30 second exposure) and with a flashlight or any other light source, carefully illuminate the subject with light, essentially 'painting' the light on your subject. It creates an image that generally can not be created with flash or natural light. It is something that I will probably do more of., maybe even on a person. But that person needs to sit really really still for a little bit of time....so we'll see.

These are the prints that I entered at WPPA State print competition....

'The Classic' was my best scoring print with an 82. 'Going Nowhere' scored a 78 as did Mutual Understanding. Our new fixer upper made the merit category with an 80. Both 'The Classic' and 'Our new fixer upper' will both hang at Nationals next Jan. I will make some changes to the other two per the judges instructions and with any luck, they will also score high enough in the national competition to 'hang'. The print judging this year was extremely tough this year, so I am satisfied with the results
